### **Audience (who)**

**Who** are the learners?

2<sup>nd</sup> year college students at Duke University, a private college in Durham, NC. The students are taking the Fairy Tales of Grimm's to Disney course within the German Language and Literature department.

### **Learning objectives (what)**
